Preheat oven to 375°. Flatten crescent rolls into large rectangle and cut into small squares. Spray mini muffin pan with cooking spray and gently push squares into muffin holes. In a medium bowl, combine eggs, cheese, ham, onions, salt and pepper. Fill muffin cups. Bake for 10 -12 minutes until golden brown. Serve while warm or reheat in microwave.
